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AFTER SCHOOL @ THE CLUB 2022-23

PROGRAM DATES/TIMES: School days from 3:00 - 6:00 PM, with extended hours on early release days at Dayton Elementary School (12:30 - 6:00 PM). Please refer to our 2022-23 Program Schedule, available at the front desk or on our website at www.theclubdayton.org/calendar.

PROGRAM FEE: Thanks to generous support, there is no cost to participate in the 2022-23 After School Program.

AGES: The program is open to students enrolled in Grades K - 5 in the 2022-23 school year. Monthly after hours events for middle and high school students are being planned and are held separate from the After School Program.

ACTIVITIES: Activities will have a focus on social and emotional learning, as we have identified those areas as a critical need to the young people of our community. There will also be activities that include arts and crafts, STEM, games, music, and more. Our programs are designed to encourage cooperation, thoughtfulness, creativity, and self-discovery.

SNACKS: Healthy snacks will be served daily and consist of fruits, vegetables, lean proteins, whole grain items, 100% fruit juice and milk. Items vary daily and are provided at no additional cost.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is there any cost to attend the after school program?

The Club's 2022-23 After School Program is being provided completely free of charge. Thanks to generous support from our partners and the community, we are able to provide the program to our community's young people at no cost to their families. However, please note that our Spring Break and Summer Programs operate separately from the After School Program, and will require additional registration and will likely have associated program fees.

How will my child get to The Club after school?

Dayton School District provides bus transportation from school to The Club. Parents/guardians of Dayton Elementary students need to contact the school to request transportation. Starbuck School District will also transport students to The Club upon request. At this time, Waitsburg School District does not provide transportation to The Club, but Columbia County Public Transportation does have a route from Waitsburg to Dayton after school. Please call CCPT at (509) 382-1647 for more information about their routes and fares.

Is daily attendance required?

No, there is no required attendance. All of our programs are voluntary and may be utilized as often or as little as needed. It is also not required for a student to remain until 6:00 PM. Parents/guardians may pick up their children at their convenience. Daily activities generally occur between 4:00 - 5:00 PM.

Will there be safety requirements in light of the COVID-19 situation?

At this time, face coverings are optional. Each student and staff member may choose to wear a mask if they wish, and they will be fully supported in their decision. Disposable masks are available for use. Surfaces and restrooms will be sanitized daily. Any changes to The Club's COVID-19 protocols will be made at the direction of public health officials and will be clearly communicated in advance.
