While program attendance rebounded modestly last year, the new school year's attendance is off the charts! Daily attendance

has increased from an average of 30 students per day to over 45, with many days seeing more than 50 students from Dayton, Waitsburg, and Starbuck participating. The daily activities,

which include art, music, STEM, reading, and much more, are a big draw. We have expanded our social and emotional learning programs, partnering with school counselors from both Dayton and Waitsburg School Districts to lead activities and offer support to students and staff.

students. Learning from industry professionals, local students are learning the finer nuances of producing, recording, and live sound. At the beginning of the school




year, we hosted a lively performance by a local high school rock band. More performances from these and other young musicians are in the works!
